


- CLARIAH Mediasuite Pilot Project: UvA, EYE Filmmuseum, NISV
- Desmet Collection and EYE's "Defragmentation" problem
 - Video annotation as a solution.
- Allow for linking and annotating materials in personal user spaces
 - Embed Desmet Collection in the CLARIAH Media Suite
 - Automated analysis of business archive

Bookmarking and Corpus Building



- Corpus building in personal user spaces
- EYE's complete Desmet Collection Metadata
- Films, posters and business archive embedded via EYE server

Segmentation and Annotation



The District Attorney's Conscience (Lubin, US, 1912)


- Going beyond Eye's archival finding aid
- Mediasuite annotation functionalities for linking films and related documents
- Explore a film's distribution and exhibition history through e.g. posters,
 letters

Automated analysis of business archive





- Materially extremely heterogeneous business archive
- EYE's metadata is an excellent starting point, but only folder-specific
- Unlock business archive with OCR and Al methods
- Data included in the CLARIAH Mediasuite with EYE's Metadata

Similar layouts






- Similarity index comparison + SIFT (scale-invariant feature transform)
- 27758 documents into 815 clusters,
 - particular individuals, specific institutions, cinemas, production companies, government institutions, grocery stores, electricians, tax forms, rental contracts, film lists, etc.

Face detection




- Frontal face

Test Cases



- <u>Test Case 1:</u> Dødsspring til Hest fra Cirkuskuplen (Dir.: Schnedler-Sørensen,
 <u>Prod.: Nordisk Films Kompagni, 1912)</u>
 - create a "historical-critical" edition primarily with what is available in the Media Suite

MIMEHIST results

- A significant and widely used historical collection added to the CLARIAH infrastructure
- Unlocking Desmet's business archive and gain new insights into distribution/exhibition history with data enrichments
- Experiment with combining methods: OCR and visual classification can support each other
